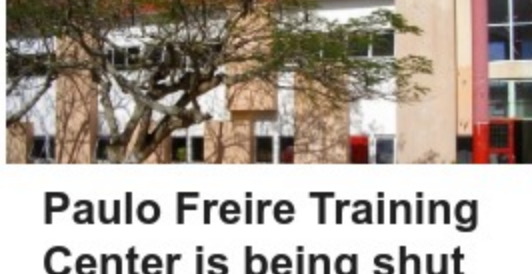

Somontes Occupation: Solidarity Message

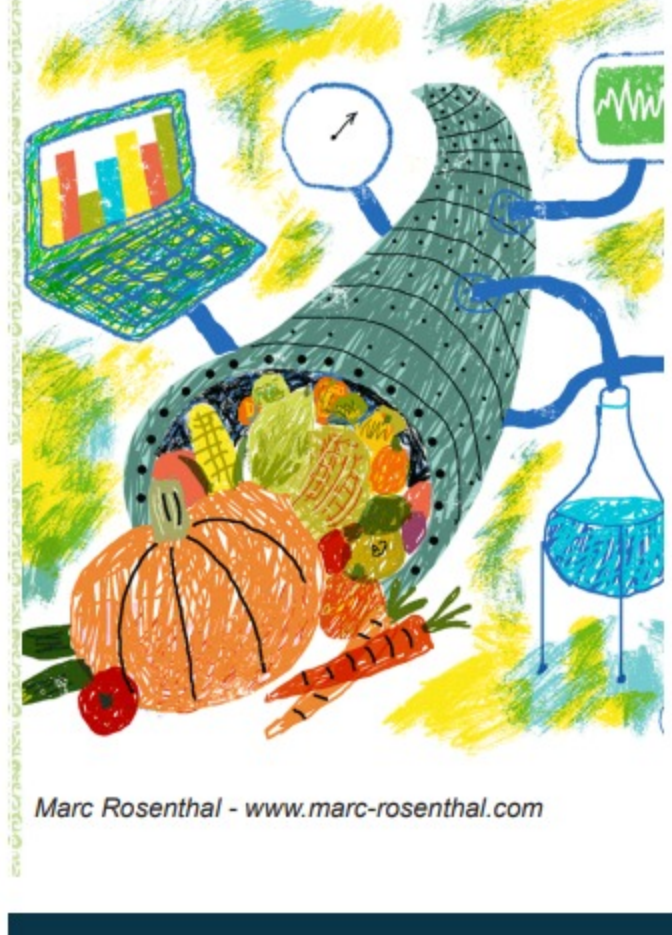

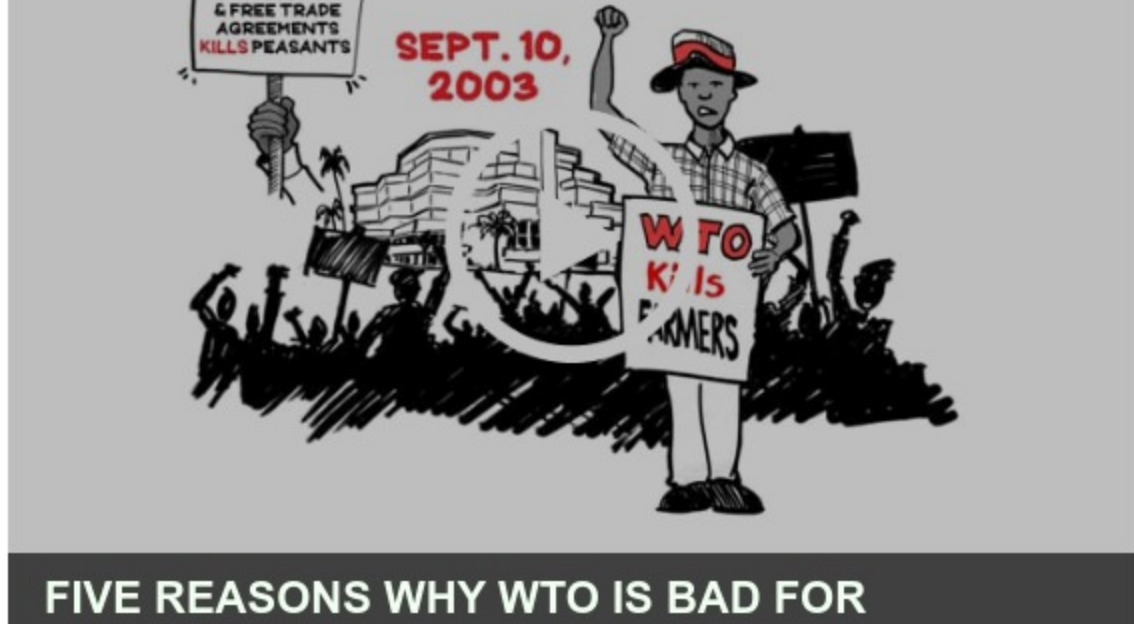
