La Via Campesina expresses its solidarity with the Indonesian Peasants' Union (SPI), an organization that brings together small farmers, landless peasants, agricultural workers, and rural communities. This solidarity arises from their struggle for agrarian reform, the reduction of emissions linked to deforestation and forest degradation, as well as their fight against subsidiaries and cooperatives that have forcibly evicted people from their land, and their efforts to reclaim and cultivate this land.

La Via Campesina calls for an end to intimidation and criminalization, and an end to legal discrimination against farmers. It also advocates for the redistribution of land to farmers through agrarian reform. At least 9 cases of such violations request our special solidarity: SPI in Muaro Jambi Regency and Batanghari Regency in Jambi Province; SPI in Tebo Regency, also in Jambi Province; SPI in Desa Mekar Jaya, Kec. Gohor Lama, Kab. Langkat, in North Sumatra Province; SPI in West Pasaman District in West Sumatra; SPI in East Tanjung Jabung in Jambi Province; SPI in Pangkalan Bulian Village, Batang Hari Leko District, Musi Banyuasin Regency in South Sumatra; SPI in Nagari Kapa, Luhak Nan Duo District, Pasaman Barat Regency, in West Sumatra; SPI in Indramayu in West Java; SPI in Pandeglang in Banten.
